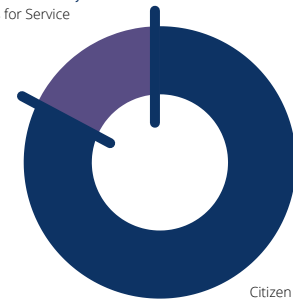

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A SUSPICIOUS PERSON AT A SHOPPING CENTER IN NW NORMAN. AN INVESTIGATION REVEALED THE INDIVIDUAL WAS HIGHLY INTOXICATED, POSSESSED NUMEROUS FIREARMS, AND IS A ROBBERY SUSPECT OUT OF OKC. EVIDENCE FROM THE ROBBERY WAS RECOVERED FROM HIS VEHICLE.
- DETECTIVES ARRESTED A SUSPECT ON FIRST DEGREE MURDER CHARGES AFTER A 14 MONTH INVESTIGATION. A SECOND SUSPECT WAS ALSO CHARGED BUT IS ALREADY IN CUSTODY IN ANOTHER COUNTY ON DIFFERING CHARGES. THE INVESTIGATION STARTED AFTER THE DEPARTMENT INVESTIGATED A CALL OF A BODY IN THE BASEMENT OF A RESIDENCE ON W. LINDSEY. OFFICERS FOUND A DECOMPOSING BODY WRAPPED UP IN A PLASTIC WRAPPED BOX.
- DETECTIVES SERVED A SEARCH WARRANT AT AN APARTMENT COMPLEX BASED ON A NCMEC CYBER TIP. DURING AN INTERVIEW, THE RESIDENT ADMITTED TO POSSESSING AND DISTRIBUTING CHILD PORNOGRAPHY.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A COLLISION BETWEEN A VEHICLE AND A TRAIN AT THE TECUMSEH RD. CROSSING. FORTUNATELY, NOBODY WAS INJURED, BUT THE TRAIN'S BRAKING SYSTEM WAS DAMAGED, AND IT BLOCKED THE ROAD FOR SEVERAL HOURS.
- SAFETY TIP: PROTECT YOURSELF FROM FRAUD. BEWARE OF DEALS THAT SOUND TOO GOOD TO BE TRUE, ABNORMAL REQUESTS, AND HIGH-PRESSURE DEMANDS SALES.
