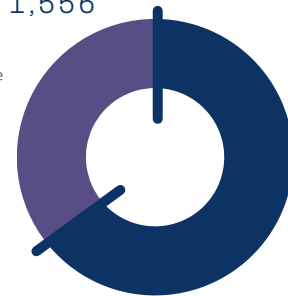

WEEK IN REVIEW

- ANIMAL WELFARE TOOK IN 72 DOGS, CATS, PUPPIES AND KITTENS. 32 ANIMALS WERE ADOPTED, 17 WERE RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS AND 2 WERE TRANSFERRED OUT TO RESCUES. THE SHELTER IS STILL AT CRITICAL CAPACITY WITH 124 ANIMALS IN OUR CARE.
- A VEHICLE VS TRAIN COLLISION OCCURRED AT LEXINGTON CROSSING WHEN THE VEHICLE BECAME STUCK ON THE TRACKS. THE OCCUPANTS WERE ABLE TO GET OUT OF THE VEHICLE BEFORE IT WAS STRUCK. NO ONE WAS INJURED.
