#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS ASSISTED THE MOORE POLICE DEPARTMENT (MPD) ON LOCATING AND ARRESTING THE SUSPECT IN A FATAL SHOOTING ON 2/14. INFORMATION FROM THE INVESTIGATION POINTED OFFICERS TO A LOCATION IN NORMAN WHERE THEY WERE ABLE TO TAKE THE SUSPECT INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT FURTHER INCIDENT. THE HOMICIDE REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY MPD.
- NORMAN POLICE ASSISTED OUPD ON THEIR RESPONSE TO A REPORT OF A SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE ON CAMPUS ON 2/16. THE NPD/OUPD HAZARDOUS DEVICES UNIT RESPONDED AND DETERMINED THE OBJECTS WERE NOT EXPLOSIVES. AN ALL-CLEAR WAS ISSUED FOR THE AREA. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY OUPD.
- DISPATCH RECEIVED INFORMATION OF A POSSIBLE THREAT TO SAFETY NEAR THE PARRINGTON OVAL ON THE OU CAMPUS ON 2/17. OFFICERS RESPONDED TO ASSIST THE OUPD BUT NO THREAT WAS LOCATED AND NO SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY WAS IDENTIFIED IN THE AREA. THE FALSE REPORT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY OUPD.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A SINGLE CAR COLLISION IN THE 16600 BLOCK OF FRANKLIN RD ON 2/16. WITNESSES REPORTED THE VEHICLE WAS DRIVING RECKLESSLY BEFORE LEAVING THE ROADWAY AND STRIKING A TREE. THE DRIVER WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL WITH LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY CIRT.
- OFFICERS ATTEMPTED A TRAFFIC STOP ON A VEHICLE DRIVING RECKLESSLY ON 2/16. THE VEHICLE DID NOT STOP AND THE OFFICER DID NOT PURSUE. A SHORT TIME LATER, COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED MULTIPLE REPORTS OF CONTINUED RECKLESS DRIVING BEHAVIOR BY A VEHICLE MATCHING THE SAME DESCRIPTION THAT WAS SPEEDING, DRIVING THROUGH RED LIGHTS, DRIVING WITHOUT THE VEHICLE'S HEADLIGHTS ON, AND ALMOST HITTING OTHER CARS. NORMAN OFFICERS AGAIN SAW THE VEHICLE DRIVING RECKLESSLY WITH NO LIGHTS NEAR ROBINSON AND 24TH AVE NW. A PURSUIT WAS INITIATED AND CONTINUED FOR SEVERAL MILES IN THE AREA. THE DRIVER WAS UNABLE TO NAVIGATE THE CURVE AT 24TH AVE NW AND FRANKLIN ROAD CAUSING THE VEHICLE TO COLLIDE WITH THE BNSF ELECTRICAL SHED. THE DRIVER RAN AND WAS ARRESTED FOLLOWING A SHORT FOOT PURSUIT. THE DRIVER AND TWO PASSENGERS WERE JUVENILES. THE DRIVER WAS TAKEN TO THE COUCH JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER AND PASSENGERS TO A JUVENILE FACILITY IN OKLAHOMA CITY.
- NORMAN POLICE CADETS FROM THE 66TH ACADEMY JOINED THE NPD MAJORS AND MEMBERS OF THE SWAT TEAM TO TAKE THE POLAR PLUNGE AND RAISE MORE THAN \$2500 FOR SPECIAL OLYMPICS OKLAHOMA.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 23 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 9 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS, AND 2 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED TO RESCUES THIS WEEK. THEY ALSO TOOK IN 56 ANIMALS. NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 127 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 22 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
